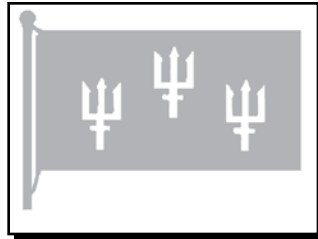

two weeks

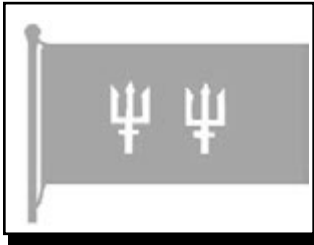


following eleven days in the hospital as a result of two heart attacks. Needless to say, I now have new appreciation for family and friends. Thank all of you who inquired and expressed concern.

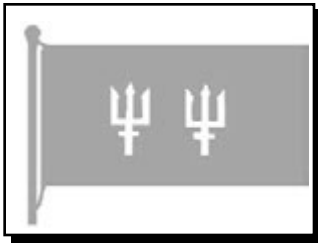
We will also be participating in the National Houseboat Expo March 12th,19th,20th.and will again need everyone's help in this endeavor.

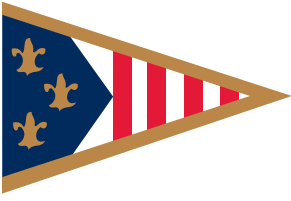
